#### Over the months

January Children's day in Thailand. A day with various activities was organised for all our children

(dances, songs and games). The children participate in a camp organised by the adolescents

of the centre.

March The children participate in a sports day organised by the staff. The children participate in

several camps organised in the region of ChiangRai.

April Thai volunteers came to teach the children how to build earth houses. Also the month of the

« Songkran » celebration, three days of festivities were organised in the home. The children

May All the children participated in the summer camp (education and reflection), organised by

the adolescents of the home. The staff took part in a training and information day linked to the risks of earthquakes and fires – practical advice, fire exercises and safety instructions

were given.

June Election of the home's children's committee for the school year 2018/2019.

July Fire exercise and safety instruction day for all the children of the home. A visit by various

members of the Government for a thorough inspection of the home: construction, security

standards and hygiene, were all found to be compliant.

August Mother's Day. A day was organised at the centre. On the program there was a show with

songs and dances as well as a special meal for the children.

Thanks to the generosity of a local fish farmer, we were able to re-populate our lake and fishpond. The children participate in several camps organised in the region of ChiangRai.

villages. A medical examination was organised for all staff.

November «Loy Krathong» celebration. A day was organised at the centre for the celebration. On the

program was the preparation of "krathongs" by the children (decorated baskets which are floated on a river) and traditional festivities. The children participated in a sports day

organised by the staff.

December In collaboration with the Government (social protection department), several days of

training were organised in aid of various NGOs in Thailand. On the program was raising

awareness and improvement in developing the field of social work.

### On a daily basis

Follow-up on the schooling.

- Learning the Thai language.
- Hmong and Akha courses (mother tongue of most of the children).
- Preservation of the ethnic traditions (sewing, embroidery, dances, songs).
- Prevention and awareness against drugs.
- General education.
- Personal care (hygiene) and prevention.
- Activities cultural, sports, animations...
- Summer program for the older children of the home (work experience placement).
- Summer program for the new residents, classes and teaching improvements.
- Active participation in the official celebrations and religious celebrations of the country, both Buddhist and Christian.
- Recruitment and training of young people for the supervision of the children.
- Children of the home occasionally offer their help to the farmers of the neighbouring villages.
- Continuation of diverse and necessary steps in making applications to the Government in order to obtain the official papers (ID card, etc.) for the children.
- Continuous support to the Thai villages and to the tribes Lahu, Lisu, Akha and Hmong.
- Continuous support to the different schools attended by our residents and by the children we support in the villages.
- Regular visits to the villages to look after the needs of the inhabitants and the follow-up of the sponsorship programme.
- Continuing contact with the indigenous people of ChiangRai Province who support our action.
- Organise reunions with the parents of the sponsored children living in the villages.
- Active attendance at various meetings organised by the Government for all the NGOs and foundations of ChiangRai province.
- Fund-raising and donations.

Continuous training of the staff through courses and seminars organised by the Government.

#### The staff

In order to assist them, Barbara and Prapapone recruited staff in the local population. This allows them to provide some work and to firmly anchor the home in the life of the region. In the interest of ensuring the continuation of the Sourire, and to ensure competent people are assisting, some former residents are called in.

#### The farm and the buildings

During the year and within the framework of the children's extracurricular activities, we farm our cornfields, rice fields and plantations; we look after our animals (pigs, cows, buffalos, etc.), cultivate our gardens and take care of the maintenance and development work.

Thanks to the support of our generous sponsors and foundations we were able to start some work projects:

- ❖ Various renovations took place the girls' showers, the library, the structure «Life is Love», which is a part of the main building.
- Construction of a kitchen/canteen for the children, with the installation of a more professional kitchen which is better adapted to the number of children.
- Construction of a store for tableware, etc.
- Construction of a toilet block for the children.
- Construction of a dam gate between the lake and the pond and the erection of a fence around a part of the lake.

A lean organisation, managed and controlled in a strict manner, the association generates minimum running costs (less than 1 % in 2017) allowing help to go directly to action on the ground.
